HAZLEWOOD LEGACY POLICIES

1. Students receiving aid must maintain a 2.00 cumulative Grade Point Average. Students must **ALSO** complete 75% of the hours they attempt. Students who feel that extenuating circumstances prevented them from achieving the academic progress standard may address a written appeal to the Director of Financial Aid.
2. Students must submit Hazlewood Exemption Form to the VA Office **ONCE** each school year.
3. Students will submit a Hazlewood Exemption Form to the VA Office **EVERY** Fall semester and the exemption will automatically be applied to all semesters through the following Summer term.
4. Students will be responsible for notifying the VA Office if they wish to stop their Hazlewood.
5. Students understand that if they do not wish to attend classes for a semester in which Hazlewood has been applied, they **MUST** formally drop classes via their myLamar or the Records Office.
6. Students are responsible for viewing their myLamar student account to verify that the Hazlewood has been applied.

If there are any questions about the new Hazlewood procedures, students should contact the VA Office **IMMEDIATELY** for clarification.
